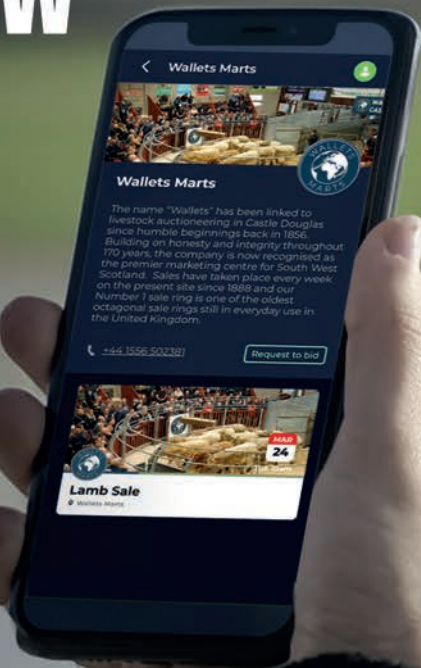

REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

(Incorporating the National Beef Association Breeding Warranties)

1. All animals will be sold in the order in which they appear in the catalogue.
2. The pedigree, history and description of each animal shall be guaranteed and warranted to be correct in all particulars by the person whose name appears as vendor, but every animal shall be sold subject to all faults. No liability whatsoever is undertaken by the Auctioneers for the statements appearing in the catalogue.
3. The Vendor/Purchasers must appreciate that although every precaution as to the safety and welfare of the animals exhibited has been taken, the Auctioneer will not be accountable for any loss or accident that may occur. The Auctioneers or Vendors will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any person attending the sale, whether as a visitor, or in any other capacity.
4. All lots will be sold in Guineas.
5. The highest approved bidder shall be the Purchaser, and if any dispute arises as to any bid, the lot in dispute shall be put up again at the last undisputed bid and re-sold or the Auctioneer may declare the Purchaser. The Auctioneer reserves the right to refuse any bid without giving a reason for doing so.
6. All lots will become the absolute property of the Purchaser from the fall of the hammer and must be paid for in full immediately after the sale and removed with all faults and errors of description.
7. All stock will be sold as they stand and no guarantees will be given. Any known defects will be announced by the Auctioneer at the time of the sale but this will in no way constitute a guarantee.
8. Should any question arise, not provided for in the foregoing rules, regulations or conditions, the decisions of the Auctioneer shall be final from which there shall be no appeal.
9. All Purchasers, whether online via MartEye or in-person should register to bid before the sale. These requests will be approved by the Auctioneers prior to the sale.
10. Terms: Debit Card transactions or BankTransfer (BACS) will be accepted on the day.
11. Please note: No animals are to be loaded without payment being made in full and a passout being obtained from the office. No passout, no animal.
12. By arrangement, animals can be left at Mayfield for up to three weeks following the sale. Any animal left longer than three weeks will be charged at £50 per animal per week. All animals are left at Mayfield at the Purchaser's risk.

In addition, the following points should be noted:

Bull Breeding Warranty

Each bull is sold with the warranty by the vendor that it is capable of getting stock by natural service. This shall be deemed to be fulfilled as soon as six females or 50% of the herd (whichever is the lesser number of the animals put to the bull are in calf to the bull by natural service subsequent to the sale. The trial period is six months from the date of sale or within six months of attaining the age of fourteen months, whichever is the later.

Female Breeding Warranties

Maiden Heifers:

Every maiden heifer over the age of twelve months at the date of sale is sold with warranties by the Vendor –

- That it shall be fertile up to the age of twenty-eight months.
- That it is not in calf.

Females In-Calf:

Every cow or heifer stated in the sale catalogue or by the Auctioneers at the time of the sale to have been served on a date not less than twelve weeks before the date of the sale is sold with warranties by the Vendor –

- That it is in calf.
- That it is in calf to the bull described in the Sale catalogue, or by the Auctioneers at the time of the sale.
- That the expected calving date will be within a period of 263 to 303 days of the service date.

Females with a Veterinary Surgeons Certificate of Positive Pregnancy Diagnosis

Scanning is a matter of opinion and NOT a warranty. Every cow or heifer stated in the sale catalogue or by the Auctioneer at the time of the sale to be sold with a Veterinary Surgeon's certificate of pregnancy diagnosis is sold with the same warranties by the Vendor as described for Females in Calf (above). Please note time limits below.

Claims and Time Limits

A claim by a Purchaser will only be valid if the Purchaser has given notice in writing to the Auctioneers of the intended claim with the following time limits:

Bull –

- Within six calendar months from the date of the sale.

Maiden Heifer or recently served heifer –

- Within three calendar months from the date of the sale, or:
- Within one calendar month from the date when the heifer attains the age of twenty-eight months, whichever is the later date.

Cow or heifer sold as being in-calf or as running with the bull and which proves not to be in-calf –

- Within twenty-eight days from the date of the sale.

Extending the Breeding Warranty

If it is found impracticable to try the bull/female fairly within the time limits stated, due to the Purchaser's normal calving programme, the Purchaser shall (at the discretion of the Vendor), ON THE DAY OF THE SALE, or within the next seven days, give the Auctioneer notice IN WRITING of the month in which it is proposed to commence using the bull/running the heifers with a bull.

Firstly, I would like to welcome you all to the catalogue of the first on-farm sale of Mayfield Beef Shorthorn bulls, females and embryos.

It is now almost nine years ago that we started our journey with Beef Shorthorn cattle at Leazes Farm. Our initial purchases were in-calf heifers from the Chapelton and Upsall herds and over the years we have purchased some other UK genetics and a lot of Australian and North American genetics to improve the genetic diversity and to help improve specific traits. All breeding decisions are made to improve both the maternal and the commercial traits of our cattle.

We feel we have a very diverse selection of genetics on offer to suit most types of farming systems. All bulls have been fully health checked and semen tested. Half the bulls are homozygous polled and there are a few with a single copy of the E226X-1 myostatin gene. Alongside the bulls we have 14 female lots (some are in-calf to Mayfield Trailblazer) and six lots of exciting embryos.

The sale day is set up to be a social day for the farming community as most of us will have just about finished lambing and calving. I would like to thank everyone who has supported this sale, the hard work which has gone on behind the scenes on farm by our stockperson Sophie Nelson and Keadyview Livestock Services to prepare the stock, as well as the support and guidance from John McCulloch and the team at Wallets Marts. Also, a huge thank you must go to those of you who have travelled to the sale and ultimately those of you lucky enough to go home with Mayfield genetics today. Thank you for all the support.

HEALTH STATUS AND VACCINATION:

The Mayfield herd has been a member of the Premium Cattle Health Scheme (PCHS) since 2017. We annually blood test all required animals for Johne's disease, Leptospirosis, IBR and Neospora. BVD is tested in calves via ear tag samples.

All sale animals have been fully vaccinated for IBR (marker vaccine), BVD and BTV-3.

PERFORMANCE RECORDING:

All our cattle are performance recorded through Breedplan and we are one of the few herds in the UK with 5-star gold standard Breedplan performance recording.

We have our own performance recording system (udders, conformation, locomotion, feet, maternal behaviour) in addition to Breedplan performance recording.

FERTILITY AND GENERAL HEALTH CHECK:

All bulls have passed a general health check and a full fertility check including semen analysis.

Female animals in the sale are in-calf already or they have passed a full fertility breeding assessment.



REFERENCE SIRES

Mayfield Rembrandt has been a gamechanger for the Beef Shorthorn breed in the UK and he is what you would define as a commercial bull with fantastic functionality.



SIRE: ROYALLA REMBRANDT K413 (Pp)

MAYFIELD REMBRANDT (Pp)

DAM: SPRYS MISS BUDDY M36 (Pp)

Rembrandt is by the famous Australian bull Royalla Rembrandt (\$48,000 AUD) and out of Sprys Miss Buddy M36, the Australian record holder for a female Beef Shorthorn price at \$95,000 AUD. In the words of Gerald Sprys, Australia, the combination of Miss Buddy M36 X Royalla Rembrandt K413 is a breeding powerhouse for breeders in the UK. Mayfield Rembrandt (ET) encompasses some of the best genetics that Sprys Shorthorns have ever produced.

Rembrandt was used on some of our heifers prior to being sold for an undisclosed sum to Fearn Farm in Scotland. Semen was retained for our own use, and we have capitalised this within our AI breeding program. He already has about 70 calves on the ground and is now the number one bull in the UK for Maternal Index. Rembrandt has an exceptionally large EMA, scrotal size and short gestation length. He brings this together with great locomotion. His first daughters have now calved, fulfilling their great expectations. They show great maternal behaviour, are milky and they have excellent udders.



SIRE: FIREFOX OF UPSALL (PP) EX 93

KHYBER OF UPSALL (P)

DAM: SECRET X547 OF UPSALL (P) EX 90

Khyber of Upsall is one of the highest indexed bulls in the UK. He combines excellent calving ease and short gestation with great growth, milk figures and large scrotal size. Khyber of Upsall is in the top 1% for Terminal Index and Self Replacing Index and in the top 5% for Maternal Index.

His sire is Firefox of Upsall who is by the famous Mandalong Super Elephant. His dam is Secret X547 of Upsall EX-90 who goes back to Sutherland Bundaberg.



SIRE: GRENADIER OF UPSALL (PP)

MAYFIELD MAXIMUS PRIMUS (Pp) EX 95

DAM: JILT X1097 OF UPSALL (Pp)

Mayfield Maximus Primus (EX-95) was our first main stock bull at Mayfield and I often describe him as beginner's luck! He combines true natural fleshing with great docility, easy calving, and he produces well milking, lovely framed daughters.

We have sold seven sons off him at Stirling and more than 20 sons off him have been sold for breeding in the UK. The consistency in his offspring is truly remarkable, which is the definition of a good breeding bull.

Maximus is a three-time winner of the North of England herd competition (2019, 2020, 2021). In 2018 he was the overall male champion of the North of England Rising Stars Calf Show and he was the overall interbreed champion at Wolsingham Show in 2021.



SIRE: WEEBOLLABOLLA THEODORE T85 (P)

MAYFIELD PRINCE THEODORE (PP) EX 92

DAM: FRIMLEY RENE DOTTIE 72R

His sire, Grenadier of Upsall, goes back to Belmore Patriarch whose sire was the famous Northern Legend. Maximus' dam is Jilt X1097 of Upsall, a large-framed cow who comes from the famous Jilts of Upsall family. Jilt's sire is Dingo of Upsall who goes back to Broughton Park Thunder who himself was sired by Weebollabolla Theodore, the most used bull over the last 20 years in Australia.

Mayfield Prince Theodore (EX-92) is one of the very few sons of Weebollabolla Theodore in the UK. Weebollabolla Theodore is a legend in our breed and he is the most used sire ever in Australia with more than 1000 offspring registered.

He still has the reputation as the best breeder of female Beef Shorthorns ever in Australia. Prince Theodore is long-bodied, correct and docile. His strength comes to the fore once his daughters calf, oozing femininity with super calm maternal behaviour around calving and they have great udders. This is the first sale where we have several of his sons for sale. One of his sons is now a stud bull for GENUS. Prince Theodore is a bull guaranteed to produce elegance and femininity.

BREEDPLAN INDIVIDUAL EBVS AND INDEXES EXPLAINED



CE % Dir = Direct Calving Ease

The EBV for direct calving ease indicates the influence of the sire on calving ease in purebred females calving at two years of age.

CE % Daughters = Daughters' Calving Ease

The EBV for daughters' calving ease indicates how easily that sire's daughters will calf at two years of age.

Gestation Length EBV (days)

An estimate of the time from conception to the birth of the calf and is based on AI and hand mating records. Lower (negative) GL EBVs indicate shorter gestation length and therefore a tendency for easier calving and increased growth after birth.

Birth Weight EBV (kg)

This is based on the measured birth weight of progeny, adjusted for dam age. The lower the value the lighter the calf at birth and the lower the likelihood of a difficult birth. This is particularly important when selecting sires for use over heifers.

200-Day Growth EBV (kg)

This is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 80 and 300 days of age. Values are adjusted to 200 days and for age of dam.

400-Day Weight EBV (kg)

This is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 301 and 500 days of age, adjusted to 400 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for yearling weight.

600-Day Weight EBV (kg)

This is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 501 and 900 days of age, adjusted to 600 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

Mature Cow \Weight EBV (kg)

This is based on the cow weight when the calf is weighed for 200 days, adjusted to five years of age.

Milk EBV (kg)

This is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV indicates the effect of the daughter's milking ability, inherited from the sire, on the 200-day weights of her calves. For dams, it indicates her own milking ability.

Scrotal Size EBV (cm)

This is calculated from the circumference of the scrotum taken between 300 and 700 days of age and adjusted to 400 days of age. This EBV is an estimate of an animal's genetic merit for scrotal size.

Carcase Weight EBV (kg)

This is based on abattoir carcass records and is an indicator of the genetic differences in carcass weight at the standard age of 650 days.

Eye Muscle Area EBV (sq cm)

This is calculated from measurements from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcass data, adjusted to a standard 300kg carcass. This EBV estimates genetic differences in eye muscle area at the 12/13th rib site of a 300kg dressed carcass. More positive EBVs indicate better muscling on animals.

Fat EBV (mm)

This is calculated from measurements of subcutaneous fat depth at the rib (from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcasses) and are adjusted to a standard 300kg carcass. This EBV indicates the genetic difference in fat distribution on a standard 300kg carcass. Sires with a low, or negative, fat EBV are expected to produce leaner progeny at any particular carcass weight than sires with higher EBVs.

Retail Beef Yield EBV (%)

This indicates genetic differences between animals for retail yield percentage in a standard 300kg carcass. Sires with larger EBVs are expected to produce progeny with higher yielding carcasses.

Intramuscular Fat EBV (%) – This is an estimate of the genetic difference in the percentage of intramuscular fat at the 12/13th rib site in a 300kg carcass. Depending on market targets, larger more positive values are generally more favourable.

Terminal Index

The Terminal Index is designed for a commercial herd using the Beef Shorthorn as a Terminal Sire on Euro cross cows. It estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for an example commercial herd targeting the production of finishing heifers and steers (average 150 days on feed). The heifers and steers are then marketed at an average of 590kg live weight (320 kg carcass weight) at 21 months of age. All progeny are slaughtered.

Self-Replacing Index

The Self Replacing Index is designed for a purebred commercial Beef Shorthorn herd that is focusing on breeding both herd replacements and finishing all steers and surplus heifers. It estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for an example herd targeting the production of finishing steers (average 150 days on feed). Steers are then marketed at an average of 650kg live weight (355kg carcass weight) at 20 months of age. Some daughters are retained for breeding.

Maternal Index

The Maternal Index is designed for a commercial Beef Shorthorn cross herd that is focussed on breeding herd replacements and on weaning as many and as heavy calves as possible at 8 months of age. It estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for an example Beef Shorthorn Euro cross commercial cow herd targeting the production of pasture grown calves. Steers and heifers are weaned and marketed at an average of 350kg live weight at 8 months of age for further finishing or as replacement heifers.
